

The Wisconsin Medical Society Foundation 2008 Raffle Official Rules

The Wisconsin Medical Society Foundation (Foundation) is a nonprofit 501(c)(3) charitable organization that seeks to advance the health of the people of Wisconsin by supporting medical and health education. Proceeds from the raffle will support that mission.

1. The purchase price of a raffle ticket is \$20 or 6 tickets for \$100. Checks or money orders should be made payable to the Wisconsin Medical Society Foundation. No part of the raffle ticket purchase is a charitable contribution. Therefore, it is not tax deductible. You may purchase a ticket from certain Foundation Trustees or by contacting the Foundation at 608-442-3800. Raffle tickets may be purchased using cash, check, money order or credit card. If the bank dishonors an entrant's check or credit card, the Foundation shall declare the entry to be invalid, and the entrant shall not have a chance to win the prize.
2. Raffle ticket purchasers may purchase more than one ticket. However, a maximum of 1,000 raffle tickets will be sold.
3. All entry forms must be completed and delivered to the Foundation on or before 7:45 p.m. on the date of the drawing, April 10, 2008.
4. The winners shall be drawn in the following order: 1) Jose Hess earrings; 2) \$1,500 travel voucher.
5. The Foundation reserves the right to post the names of the winners on the Wisconsin Medical Society's (Society) Web site and to use the winners' names in articles or other materials that describe or discuss the raffle. By accepting the prize, the winner agrees to permit the Foundation to use his or her name and to take and post a photograph on the Society's Web site and in articles or other materials that discuss the raffle.
6. Any person may send a self-addressed, stamped envelope to the Wisconsin Medical Society Foundation, 330 E. Lakeside Street, Madison, WI 53715, to obtain the name of the winner.
7. The winners will be determined by a random drawing held at 8:00 p.m. during the 2008 Fundraising Dinner and Silent Auction at the Monona Terrace Convention Center on April 10, 2008. There will be two winners—one for each of the two listed prizes. The winner does not have to be present to win. In the event that the winner is not present at the time of the drawing, the Foundation shall attempt to contact the winner within seven calendar days of the drawing using the information on the entry form.

8. The winner shall assume and be responsible for all local, state and federal taxes, including without limitation all applicable sales, use, luxury, income and special taxes. The Foundation specifically disclaims all express or implied warranties including warranties of merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose regarding the construction and/or condition of the television, moped, or any other prize offered in the raffle.

9. More than one name may be stated on the registration form; however, the first listed name shall be deemed the "entrant." The Social Security number of the entrant must be provided to claim a prize. Payment or delivery of any prize shall be made solely to the entrant. It is the sole responsibility of the entrant in the multiple party entry to allocate any such prize among the other participants in the multiple party.

10. The winners shall be responsible for making all arrangements regarding and related to delivery and/or transportation of the prizes. Winners shall release the Foundation from responsibility and/or liability regarding the delivery, receipt, condition or use of the prize awarded.

11. The decision of the Foundation shall be final on all matters concerning the raffle.
