Treatment of Opioid Use Disorder Course

Includes Waiver Qualifying Requirements

The Drug Abuse Treatment Act of 2000 (DATA 2000) specifies training necessary for prescribers to obtain a waiver to engage in office-based treatment of opioid use disorders with buprenorphine. This course addresses those requirements using a curriculum approved by CSAT/SAMHSA and ASAM, the organizations named in the DATA 2000 legislation as eligible to prepare and administer these courses.

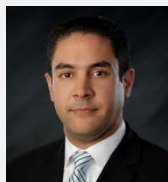
FACULTY



Aleksandra Zgierska, MD, PhD, DFASAM (course director) is an Assistant Professor at the University of Wisconsin-Madison (UW) Department of Family Medicine and Community Health (DFMCH). She is board-certified in family medicine and addiction medicine, and provides care at UW Health. She serves as a faculty at the UW Addiction, Pain Medicine, and Research fellowships, and is a Board of Directors member at the American Society of Addiction Medicine (ASAM) and the Wisconsin Society of Addiction Medicine (WISAM). She is an immediate-past president of WISAM, and ASAM's Distinguished Fellow. Her research focuses in improving outcomes in chronic pain and addiction.



Randall Brown, MD, PhD, DFASAM is an Associate Professor at the UW DFMCH. He is board-certified in family medicine and addiction medicine, and provides care for patients with substance use disorders at UW Health and Access clinics, UW Hospital, and the Madison VA. He is the Founding Director of the UW-VA Addiction Medicine Fellowship Programs, directs the UW Hospital Center for Addictive Disorders and the American Board of Addiction Medicine and the Addiction Medicine Foundation. He is President Elect of the Addiction Medicine Fellowship Directors Association. His research focuses on the treatment and prevention of substance use disorders and related complications in settings outside of the specialist treatment settings.



Maireni Cruz, MD, FACP is a Clinical instructor at the UW DFMCH. He is board-certified in internal medicine, and provides care for patients with alcohol and drug use disorders at UW Hospital and Clinics and Access clinics. He will join the UW DFMCH faculty as an Assistant Professor and be eligible for the board exam in addiction medicine later in 2018, after he completes the UW Addiction Medicine Fellowship.

Space is limited. Therefore, the registration will be on the “first come, first serve” basis, with an on-site registration available space-permitting.

To register online, please follow the above link, which will take you to the page for The ASAM Buprenorphine Course. If not, please click on the “Cart” tab located on the right. On this page will be the cost of the course with fields for you to input your information. Please enter all required information. You may begin the online portion of the course after completing the registration process.

On-site registration (space permitting) will require a completion of a registration form; a valid credit card number will be needed for the on-site non-trainee registrants.

Continuing Medical Education Credits (CME)

The American Society of Addiction Medicine (ASAM) is accredited by the Accreditation Council for Continuing Medical Education (ACCME) to provide continuing medical education for physicians. The ASAM designates the online material for a maximum of **4 AMA PRA Category 1 Credits™**, and this live course for a maximum of **4 AMA PRA Category 1 Credits™**. Clinicians should claim credit commensurate with the extent of their participation in the activity.*

* The combined online enduring material and live activity will provide the required 8 hours needed to obtain the waiver to prescribe buprenorphine in office-based treatment of opioid use disorders. *

Attendees must complete the online portion within 30 days of the live course in order to be eligible for a waiver. They must complete both the online and live portions in order to receive credit and be eligible for the waiver; partial credit cannot be claimed. Attendees can claim credit in the e-Learning Center after they complete both portions of the course.

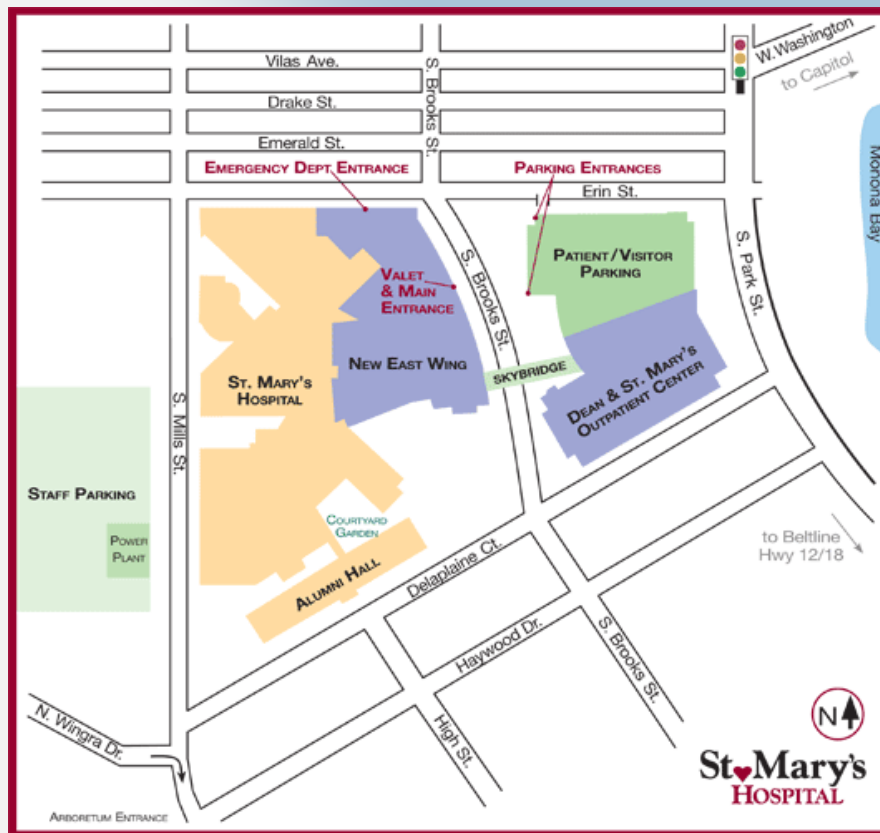

Travel directions to the St. Mary's Hospital Parking Ramp:

1. Coming from the Beltline: the sign reads N 151 Park Street. This is South Park Street, exit north.
2. Pass the Mister Car Wash on your right.
3. Turn left (west) at the lights to Erin Street.
4. Turn left into the parking ramp across the street from the hospital.



Directions from the parking ramp to Sr. Mary Jean Ryan Conference Centers- Bay 1:

Please bring in your parking ticket to be validated at the information desk.

- Take the elevator in the ramp to Level 1. Turn left and walk past the pharmacy and Digestive Health Center.
- Take the Skybridge to the hospital, and **Stop at the information desk on the right to get your parking ticket validated.**
- Continue straight toward the Bistro/dining area,
